

Job description – Industrial Painter (U. A. E.)

Job description:

- Perform paint process applications to metals parts
- Operate spray booth, oven, manual powder guns and ventilation system per specific instructions
- Set up machinery and ensure all production materials are available
- Prior to painting, clean and prepare part surfaces as specified to be contamination free
- Hang or set-up parts prior to painting
- Ability to use a variety of paint equipment including, gravity, pressure and air assist
- Complete tasks as directed by manufacturing schedules
- Maintain cleanliness of equipment and assigned area
- Perform the setup and operation of machines on designated lines according to the production schedule
- Perform some daily maintenance and/or repair work on equipment as needed
- Inspect parts after painting for needed repairs, proper thickness and general appearance
- Ensure all safety devices are fully operational and that safety procedures are being observed
- Liaise with the factories for coordination and processing orders and technical clarifications
- Determine manpower, equipment and raw materials needed to cover production demand

Qualifications:

- Experience with spray painting in an industrial setting is a plus
- Experience with minor mechanical repairs (e.g., jams, using tools, making basic adjustments to equipment, etc.)
- Ability to work independently, manage multiple assignments, and meet tight deadlines
- Experience with preventative maintenance (e.g., inspecting and maintaining equipment, detecting and correcting issues before they occur, etc.)
- Experience in metal fabrication or parts manufacturing a preferred
- Ability to work independently and in isolation
- High school diploma or equivalent
- Technical degree is an advantage
- Ability to work effectively as a team member

- Ability to work in a multicultural environment
