## Job description – Machine Operator (U. A. E.)

### Job description:

- Responsible for machine operation (Press brakes, welding machines, saws, drills and grinders)
- Set up machinery and ensure all production materials are available
- Operate and monitor equipment and replenish materials as needed
- Visually inspect production run and document results
- Determine and report malfunctions to appropriate parties
- Maintain cleanliness of equipment and assigned area
- Perform the setup and operation of machines on designated lines according to the production schedule
- Perform some daily maintenance and repair work on equipment as needed
- Perform periodic quality checks and tests to ensure the best quality products are being produced
- Ensure all safety devices are fully operational and that safety procedures are being observed
- Liaise with the factories for coordination and processing orders and technical clarifications
- Understand and incorporate feedback from manufacturing and CAD engineers
- Coordinate production workflow for multiple products
- Plan and prioritize operations to ensure maximum performance and minimum delay
- Determine manpower, equipment and raw materials needed to cover production demand
- Create and assemble job packets
- Continuously improve quality and cost

### Qualifications:

- Prior manufacturing machine operation experience preferred
- Experience with minor mechanical repairs (e.g., jams, using tools, making basic adjustments to equipment, etc.)
- Experience with preventative maintenance (e.g., inspecting and maintaining equipment, detecting and correcting issues before they occur, etc.)
- High school diploma or equivalent
- Technical degree is an advantage
- Experience with 2D and 3D CAD drawings
- Ability to operate a forklift is preferred
- English communication skills
- Ability to work in a multicultural environment
- Mechanical engineering background is preferred
- A team-player, self-motivated and very well organized
- Ability to work independently, manage multiple assignments, and meet tight deadlines
